

What is the Westie Waggle?

The Westie Waggle is our major kid-powered FUNdraiser! This event will take place on October 9th. As part of the Westie Waggle, the students will collect donations from friends, family and neighbors, and celebrate with an outdoor Waggle-thon! Students will run, walk, jump, hop and dance their way around the track, complete with a DJ led dance party and some fun "obstacles" for kids who wish to challenge themselves! Every class will be granted an extra recess period on October 9th to participate in the Westie Waggle.

Does my child need to sell something?

No! The Westie Waggle is a donation-based FUNdraiser. Students collect "pledges" or donations for this event from friends and family. There is nothing to sell!

How do we get donations?

Students are encouraged to ask family, friends and neighbors to support them in this endeavor! Donations are flat amounts, not subject to the length of participation. Donations are also tax deductible!! Cash or checks made out to VESPTO can be collected and submitted through the attached Westie Waggle envelope prior to, or on the day of the event. Please do not have your child do any door to door soliciting.

If you do not wish to ask family, friends and neighbors for a donation, please consider making a donation on behalf of your child or children!

What is the fundraising goal, and what does the PTO do with the money?

Money earned from the Westie Waggle will be used to support large scale school projects. Funds raised will help support programs that encourage physical activity for our students, upgrading computer systems and increasing technology in the classrooms, and supporting our classroom and specialty teachers with the resources they need to implement programs that enhance our students' academic experience. Will children receive prizes and incentives for their efforts?

Yes! Every student will receive a prize for their efforts!

- The student with the highest dollar amount of pledges earned will serve as "Principal for the Day"! This coveted award will be scheduled after the event, at a time agreed upon by Mrs. Kirby and the winning student's classroom teacher.
